

# Haiti

**Hurricane Matthew hit Haiti late on 3rd October 2016 leaving over 300 000 people in need of emergency assistance. Worst hit was the south western tip of the country.**

Seventeen Integral Members are responding. This information was collected during a joint needs assessment in nine of the most affected communities carried out by four Integral Members working together.



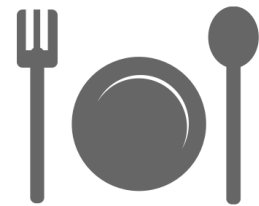
## Access

Some communities can only be reached by boat after the main bridge to the southern part of the island was swept away.



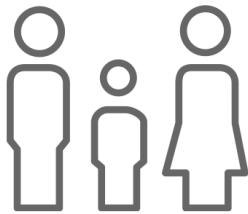
## Shelter

In some areas, up to 90% of homes have been completely destroyed.



## Food

Community members reported now eating only one meal a day; they have lost crops and livelihoods.



## Protection

Vulnerable groups are at increased risk, including children, disabled and elderly people.



## Water

Clean drinking water is not available in most locations due to the damage caused by the hurricane.



## Health

Cholera is a major threat due to lack of clean water.
