Two high-magnitude earthquakes hit Venezuela on 24 June destroying homes and buildings across the north of the country. As of 30 June at least 1,700 people are reported to have died. While search and rescue efforts continue, the number of fatalities is expected to rise. More than 5,000 people have been injured and 12,700 people have been left without shelter. Affected communities are in urgent need of safe shelter, access to clean water and sanitation, food and essential household items.
